NEW ANALYSIS SHOWS THAT CURRENT “BOTTLE BILL” IS HURTING BUSINESSES AND COSTING JOBS

RECENT REVIEW SHOWS THAT FAILURE TO MODERNIZE LAW HAS RESULTED IN AT LEAST 97 REDEMPTION CENTER CLOSURES

GROUPS CALL ON STATE LAWMAKERS TO MODERNIZE BOTTLE BILL – COVER MORE BEVERAGES, INCREASE DEPOSIT, HIKE HANDLING FEE

(Albany, N.Y.) A coalition supporting improving the state’s Bottle Deposit Law today released a review of recent redemption center closures. The review, conducted by redemption centers, identified 97 businesses that have closed or appear to be closed. Another 54 redemption centers had disconnected phones and no obvious social media presence. The coalition argued that many of these closures are the direct result of New York’s fifteen year “freeze” of the handling fee redemption centers rely on for revenues. (A listing of the closures is attached.)

The groups urged state lawmakers to support modernizing New York’s 40 year old Bottle Deposit Law (S.237-C/A.6353-A). That legislation would increase the handling fee to help benefit redemption centers and other businesses and non-profits that collect redeemable beverage containers.

The legislation would also cover virtually all beverage containers (current law only covers carbonated beverages and water bottles), increase the deposit from a nickel to a dime (it’s been a nickel since 1983), and increase the handling fee (which has been in place since 2009). The handling fee would be increased to adjust for inflation.

The coalition cited the widespread support for the changes including over 300 civic, religious, environmental, and businesses that have urged support for the legislation. (A list of those groups is attached.)

The Bottle Deposit Law requires that consumers purchasing a covered beverage container must pay a nickel deposit which can be redeemed by the consumer. The Law is considered a great success and has drastically reduced litter and stimulated recycling in New York.

Comments for BIGGER BETTER BOTTLE BILL | S237C / A6353A (Senator May / Assemblymember Glick, REDEMPTION RELIEF BILL | S6869A / A7557A (Senator May / Assemblymember Glick)

Dear New York State Representatives,

The Empire State Redemption Association represents approximately 120 Redemption Centers across New York State. The redemption industry is estimated to directly and indirectly employ approximately 20,000 New Yorkers. These employees rely on a healthy redemption industry to feed their families, support local community centers, clean their local environments, and better overall society.

The Redemption Industry is currently in distress due to critical aspects of the Bottle Bill remaining unchanged since 2009, and in some cases, since the bill was originally passed in 1983. To ensure the continued viability of Redemption Centers and their invaluable community contributions, it is essential for New York State to pass the Bigger and Better Bottle Bill (S237C/A6353A), championed by Senator May and Assemblymember Glick. This bill proposes to:

- Increase handling fees from 3.5 cents to 6 cents.
- Raise the deposit on containers from 5 cents to 10 cents.
- Expand the range of containers covered under the deposit system to include coffee, teas, sport drinks, wine, liquor, and ciders.

Since the last increase in the handling fee in 2009, inflation has risen by 46%. This is starkly illustrated by the rise in the minimum wage, which was \$7.50 in 2009 and is now at least \$15 in many parts of the state. Redemption Centers are among the few businesses that cannot control the cost of their services, as these costs are fixed by the state. The lack of adjustment to the handling fee to account for modern inflation has forced nearly 150 Redemption Centers to close their doors in the past two years alone. These closures result in job losses, increased pollutants, and consumers left without options to redeem their deposits.

New York taxpayers also stand to gain through the passage of a modernized Bottle Bill. A study conducted by the Container Recycling Institute (CRI) and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYS DEC) found that municipalities across the state could save approximately \$70 million a year. A modernized deposit program would divert low-quality material out of the waste stream, turning it into high-quality material that will fuel New York State's circular economy.

Finally, there are thousands of community centers, non-profits, and organized groups that have signed onto letters showing their support for a modernized Bottle Bill and/or the passage of the Redemption Relief Bill (S6869A/A7557A), also championed by Senator May and Assemblymember Glick. This bill has bipartisan support and is seen as an emergency backup to provide relief to redemption centers if the modernized Bottle Bill does not pass.

The majority of New Yorkers support a modernized Bottle Bill, understanding the environmental and economic benefits it brings. By updating the Bottle Bill, New York can ensure the sustainability of Redemption Centers, protect jobs, and continue leading in environmental stewardship.

We urge you to support the Bigger and Better Bottle Bill for the continued health and prosperity of our state's redemption industry, environment, and communities.
