BIGGER, BETTER, BOTTLE BILL BENEFITS TAXPAYERS, CHARITIES, BUSINESSES

REDUCES LITTER, HELPS CLEAN ENVIRONMENT

MARKING 500 DAYS SINCE RELEASE OF THE DEC'S "SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN" WITH NO SIGNIFICANT STATE ACTION TO REDUCE PACKAGING WASTE, COALITION CALLS FOR PASSAGE OF S.5684/A.6543

(Albany, N.Y.) Marking the 500th day since the Department of Environmental Conservation released its once-in-a-decade "[Solid Waste Management Plan](#)," a coalition of environmental, charities, and small businesses today called on the State Senate and Assembly to pass the Bigger, Better, Bottle Bill ([S.5684/A.6543](#)) and the "Packaging Reduction and Recycling Infrastructure Act" ([S.1464/A.1749](#)).

The groups cited the failure of the state to attack the mounting packaging and beverage container trash crisis as a compelling rationale for legislative action this session. All of the state's landfills are set to fill up within the next 25 years, but there's no plan in place to reduce waste and stave off a crisis. The groups urged approval of packaging and bottle bill legislation to help curb New York's mounting garbage problem.

Approval of the "Bigger, Better, Bottle Bill" would benefit state revenues, save local taxpayers money, support struggling businesses, and charities that provide critical services to the needy. Among other measures, the bill expands the current redemption system from just carbonated beverages and water to all containers (other than dairy and 100% juice beverages). It raises the deposit from a nickel (set in 1982!) to a dime, which will result in a dramatic increase in returned containers – thus reducing litter and trash to be dumped.

Taxpayers: The Bigger, Better Bottle Bill expansion provides major financial benefits to New York's municipalities as well as the state. [Research](#) recently estimated that expanding the law could save New York's municipalities between \$40 million and \$100 million annually through

waste diversion while recycling an additional 5.5 billion containers. Expansion could also [generate](#) as much as \$100 million to support environmental programs.

Businesses: The bill would also provide badly-needed support to struggling redemption center businesses. According to a recent [estimate](#), over 100 redemption centers have closed due to the state's failure to regularly update the "handling fee" – which hasn't been increased since 2009. The legislation would update the fee to reflect inflation.

Charities: There are over 1,000 charities whose fundraising includes the redemption of unredeemed beverage containers. The charities view the Bigger, Better, Bottle Bill as a way to boost revenues for vital services for the needy.

Moreover, individuals who work to collect and return unredeemed containers ("**canners**") would see a significant increase in their ability to supplement their incomes to help cover rising costs.

Environmentalists cited [research](#) which showed that the legislation would "lead to an additional 5.5 billion beverage containers recycled and **diverted from disposal** (e.g., landfill, incineration) or littered annually"; would **reduce greenhouse gas emissions** in New York State to the equivalent to removing 83,500 gasoline-power passenger vehicles from the road per year"; and, would lead to an approximate 34% **litter reduction** for beverage containers across New York state."

AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to returnable bottles; to direct the multi-agency bottle bill fraud investigation team to submit a report on findings of pervasive bottle redemption fraud in New York state; and to repeal section 27-1018 of such law relating to the beverage container assistance program

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS: This legislation proposes to implement an expansion and modernization of the state’s Bottle Bill. Relates to returnable bottles; adds non-carbonated beverages (such as iced teas and sports drinks) wine, liquor, distilled spirit coolers, and cider and wine products to the definition of "beverage", increases the container deposit from five cents to ten cents, and provides that the handling fee will be increased in three phases culminating at 6.5 cents for each beverage container accepted by a deposit initiator from a dealer or operator of a redemption center.

STATEMENT OF SUPPORT: New York faces a solid waste crisis while municipal recycling programs struggle. With landfills nearing capacity and the state's recycling rate remaining flat over the past decade,¹ it is time to update and expand the state's highly successful container deposit redemption program.

The New York State Returnable Container Act went into effect in 1983 and requires a 5-cent refundable deposit to be placed on eligible beverage containers. The law requires retailers who sell covered beverages to accept returns of empty containers for the products they sell and refund the deposits, and it requires beverage distributors to pay retailers a handling fee for the cost of collecting empty containers.

Much of New York is struggling with an ongoing solid waste crisis. The costs of recycling containers that are not covered under the state's Bottle Bill are too high for many municipalities. For example, the costs associated with collecting and processing PET plastic bottles and glass per ton are higher than revenues per ton they can fetch as scrap material.² Expanding the Bottle Bill would reduce or eliminate these costs by creating a financial incentive for consumers to return and an obligation for retailers to accept these containers, relieving the burden on municipal recycling programs. **Bottle Bill expansion would provide major financial benefits to New York's municipalities as well as the state. The research think tank *Eunomia* estimates that expanding the law could save New York's municipalities between \$40 million and \$100 million annually through waste diversion³ while recycling an additional 5.5 billion containers.⁴ Already, the unclaimed bottle deposits generate millions of dollars that are used to support environmental programs statewide through New York's General Fund. NYPIRG estimates that a Bottle Bill expansion could generate as much as \$100 million in additional revenues for the state.⁵ And at the same time, the redemption rate will increase with the deposit set at a dime and the overall recycling rate should increase with the expansion of redeemable bottles and cans.**

An expansion of the bottle bill would also include raising the handling fee, which has not been increased in 16 years. The "handling fee" is the funding stream for redemption centers to handle redeemable containers. The costs of running a business have significantly increased over the past 16 years, but the handling fee has not. Recently, more than 100 centers have had to close, due at least partially to the "frozen" handling fee.⁶ Those closures undermine the program, reducing consumer convenience, and costing the state jobs.

Additionally, an expansion of the Bottle Bill would result in increased economic opportunities for New Yorkers. If the law is modernized, New Yorkers can expect 1,866 new jobs to be created.⁷ Additionally, many low-income New Yorkers, often within immigrant, senior, or homeless communities, rely upon the practice of "canning" to supplement their income. According to the organization *Sure We Can*, an estimated 10,000 New Yorkers are part of New York City's canning community alone.⁸ Increasing the deposit and expanding the types of containers covered by the law will bring new money into the canning community.

Specifically, there are two key changes contained in this legislation that modernize the Bottle Bill:

- The legislation expands the types and number of beverage containers covered by the Bottle Bill. Other states from Maine to California include a diverse range of non-carbonated beverages, wine, and liquor with great success.⁹
- The legislation increases the amount of the deposit to a dime and directs a portion of the additional revenues collected by the state to ensure better compliance and enhance access to redemption entities in currently underserved communities. *Raising the deposit to a dime has broad, bipartisan support.*¹⁰ States like Michigan and Oregon that have increased their deposit to a dime have seen increases in recycling and container redemption rates.¹¹

Over its more than 40-year history, New York's Bottle Bill has proven highly effective at reducing litter and increasing recycling rates. In 2023, New York's redemption rate was at 68%.¹² The Bottle Bill has reduced roadside container litter by 70%.¹³ However, the law can do far more. By expanding the law to cover more types of containers and increasing the deposit to a dime, New York can increase recycling rates, reduce litter further, reduce strain on municipal waste systems, and help support environmental programs statewide. **Our organizations urge your support of this important legislation.**
